



VISITOR ACCESS REGULATIONS

94th Annual ICOLD Meeting

In order to maintain safety conditions for all personnel within the Ing. Alfredo Elías Ayub "La Yesca" Hydroelectric Plant (H.P.), and to safeguard the interests of the Comisión Federal de Electricidad (Federal Electricity Commission).

1. All attendees must have prior registration before boarding the transport that will take them to the Plant.
2. The dress code is mandatory: long-sleeved cotton shirt and gabardine or denim pants. **Not permitted: short-sleeved shirts, tops, t-shirts, shorts, dresses, skirts.**
3. Closed-toe shoes with natural or non-slip soles must be worn. **Not permitted: sandals, sneakers, heels.**
4. Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the facilities.
5. VISITORS under the influence of alcohol, stimulants, or narcotics will not be permitted entry to the facilities; it is also strictly prohibited to introduce these substances into the Plant.
6. It is prohibited to bring firearms, bladed weapons, sharp objects, or explosives into the facilities.
7. During the visit, a responsible guide is essential; this guide will inform visitors of internal risks.
8. Running, playing games, separating from the group, or performing any activity other than the purpose of the visit is strictly prohibited.
9. The entry of photographic cameras or video recordings with drones in the airspace of the Plant facilities is not permitted.
10. Photographs with cell phones are only permitted in open areas; taking photographs and videos with cell phones, professional cameras, or any device inside the Machine House is strictly prohibited.
11. The supplied safety equipment must be used mandatorily.

12. When passing through areas where there is a noise risk indication, please use the specific protective equipment.
13. Operational areas cannot be visited without accompaniment or authorization from Plant personnel.
14. Do not touch or operate the Plant's equipment.
15. In case of hearing an alarm, proceed immediately to the nearest meeting point, following the instructions of the Floor Supervisor or Brigade Member.
16. Comply with the norms, regulations, and signage within the Plant.
17. Access is not permitted for minors or persons not part of the visiting group.
18. The authorities of this Plant may deny access or order the exit of any person who obstructs the operation of services or fails to comply with these rules.
