



OPTION 3 - 2-DAY TOUR

Day 1: Historic Center and Basilica of Guadalupe: The Spiritual and Monumental Heart of the Country

Begin your exploration in Mexico City's Historic Center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here, among cobblestone streets and stone facades, history blends with modern bustle.

Walk through the Zócalo, one of the largest squares in the world, surrounded by architectural treasures: the Metropolitan Cathedral, with its impressive Baroque altarpiece and Gothic towers, and the Templo Mayor, a visual journey through the history of Mexico's first settlers, Tenochtitlan. Lunch will take place at the iconic Bajío Restaurant, with its stunning colonial architecture, formerly the home of Saint Anne.

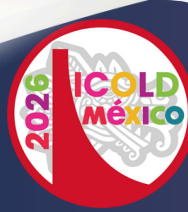
Later, the route will take you to the Basilica of Guadalupe, where millions of pilgrims flock each year to pay homage to Mexico's patron saint. The modernity of the main temple, designed with a copper dome and a circular structure that allows the Virgin's mantle to be seen from any vantage point, is complemented by the ancient 16th-century chapels that crown Tepeyac Hill.

The complex forms a serene and majestic space, ideal for those seeking spiritual relaxation as well as those who enjoy architecture and living traditions.

OPTION 2 - 3-DAY TOUR

Day 2 - Coyoacán and Xochimilco: Art, Color, and Floating Traditions

Day 2 will take you to the south of the city, where Mexico's artistic and festive spirit flourishes.

The morning will begin in Coyoacán, one of the capital's most charming and oldest neighborhoods.

Its cobblestone streets, colorful mansions, gardens, and lively plazas invite you to stroll leisurely.

Here you can visit the famous Casa Azul, Frida Kahlo's home, where each room preserves the artist's creative and passionate spirit. The neighborhood's atmosphere, filled with cafes, bookstores, and galleries, offers an intimate and bohemian respite that delights all visitors.

Later, the tour continues to Xochimilco, a World Heritage Site that preserves the canals of ancient Tenochtitlán. You'll sail on colorful trajineras, accompanied by mariachi music, traditional dishes, and the smiles of local vendors selling everything from flowers to tamales and handicrafts. The day ends with free time at the local artisan market before returning to the hotel, where you can find traditional goods and colorful textiles to take home as souvenirs. A short experience, but full of memorable moments: history, art, nature, and Mexican hospitality, all in just two days.
